

# Wildlife Field Technician Support

## Beale Air Force Base, CA



### POSITION

A Wildlife Field Technician Support position is available with Colorado State University (CSU) and the Center for Environmental Management of Military Lands (CEMML), and will be located at Beale Air Force Base, California. Beale AFB is approximately 23,000-acre and located in Yuba County, California. The base is located east of Marysville and Yuba City and about 40 miles from Sacramento in the rolling hills of northern California.

### ORGANIZATION

The Center for Environmental Management of Military Lands (CEMML) is a multidisciplinary team of natural, physical, and social scientists. We work closely with the Department of Defense and other agencies to inform management of natural and cultural resources consistent with achieving mission-specific and societal goals. CEMML is part of Colorado State University's Warner College of Natural Resources.

### RESPONSIBILITIES

This position will support to the activities of the CSU Wildlife Biologists and addresses a broad range of tasks, including the following:

- Avian power pole mortality surveys
- Monitor barn owl, kestrel, and blue bird nesting boxes.
- Assist with special status species surveys.
- Invasive species removal including Early Detection Rapid Response monitoring
- GIS Mapping
- Nesting bird surveys
- Restoration site maintenance

### QUALIFICATIONS

- Must be able to walk long distances in adverse terrain and weather conditions.
- Must be actively working towards or have a BS/BA in ecology, natural resource management, or related field.
- Must have course work and/or experience with natural resource sampling and monitoring techniques.
- Must have some experience navigating with maps, compasses, and GPS.
- Must be able to work well with others.
- Must have or be able to obtain a valid driving license.
- Must have a clean driving record.
- Must be eligible to work in the United States by the proposed start date. CEMML will not provide visa sponsorship for this position.
